Travel History Declaration – UK, France and Republic of Ireland

- 1) Mariners are advised that from 00:01 Wednesday 2nd September, the UK, France and Republic of Ireland will be split into regions in the the traffic light system for assessing travel history for persons arriving in Jersey. All other countries will continue to be assessed by country and not regionally at this time.
- 2) Passengers arriving in Jersey will be required to disclose their travel history for the 14 days prior to their planned arrival in Jersey. This includes their country of departure, and any other countries or regions they have visited or will have visited in this 14-day period.
- 3) Depending on their information provided, passengers may be required to self-isolate for up to 14 days on their arrival in Jersey and may also be asked to undergo an additional test 5 days after arrival.
