Parking, Speed and Traffic Restrictions

1. Purpose

- 1.1. The purpose of this Direction is to set out the Parking, Speed and Traffic Restrictions at Jersey Airport

2. Scope

- 2.1. The following parking, speed and traffic restrictions apply within the aerodrome areas administered by Ports of Jersey Limited.

3. Responsibilities

- 3.1. The oversight and enforcement of this Direction will be carried out by Ports of Jersey employees and third parties authorised by the Airport Director.

4. General Direction

- 4.1. This General Direction is issued in accordance with the Powers of Airport Director as set out in the Aerodromes (Jersey) Regulations 1965.

5. Parking

- 5.1. This direction sets out the General Provisions relating to Airport Parking Infractions in the table below.

Road Traffic (St. Peter) (Jersey) Order 1992 - Article 7: Restriction on parking (3)

- 5.2. General Provisions are set out in the following table:

General Provisions	Infraction Description – The following are prohibited	Time of Restriction
GP - 1	Waiting in a prohibited area	Anytime
GP - 2	Leaving a vehicle unattended in a restricted zone	Anytime
GP - 3	Causing an obstruction within an aerodrome parking area	Anytime
GP - 4	Waiting on a road within 10 yards of the junction of another road	Anytime
GP - 5	Waiting on a stand set aside for public service vehicles (taxis, booked cabs, bus, coaches)	Anytime
GP - 6	Waiting on a "No Waiting" area, preventing access to premises	Anytime
GP - 7	Waiting on a "No Parking" area, preventing access to premises	Anytime
GP - 8	Unauthorised use of an unloading bay	Anytime

GP - 9	Waiting on a "Disabled Drivers" parking area	Anytime
GP - 10	Parked in a permit holders' area without a permit displayed	Anytime
GP - 11	Parked in a commercial vehicle parking area	Anytime
GP - 12	Parked in a restricted area reserved for courtesy minibuses and Airport Authority vehicles	Anytime
GP - 13	Obstructing an Emergency Access Exit	Anytime
GP - 14	Other (i.e., stopping/waiting on hatched yellow lines, pavements)	Anytime

Area	Definition
Prohibited areas	Access road to the Air Traffic Tower Access road to the Fire Station Bull ring area outside arrivals terminal building. Within 2 meters of the airport perimeter fence
Restricted Zones	Drop off zone outside departures terminal building. Car hire designated parking area.

5.3. Detailed parking restrictions relating to specific Aerodrome areas can be found at Annex B.

5.4. If any person contravenes any direction issued by the airport authority under the Aerodromes (Jersey) Regulations 1965, they shall be liable to a fine of level 2 on the standard scale (as defined in the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1993.

6. Speed Limits

- 6.1. Speed limits within the Aerodrome are as below:
- 6.1.1. 15 miles per hour on all roads within the aerodrome area; and
 - 6.1.2. 5 miles per hour within all aerodrome car parks.

7. Window Displayed Insurance Discs

- 7.1. This direction sets out ability for Ports of Jersey employees and third parties authorised by the Airport Director to check vehicles parked within the aerodrome areas to ensure they have a valid insurance disc displayed as required by the Motor Traffic (Third Party Insurance) (Jersey) Law 1948.


8. One-Way Traffic

- 8.1. All traffic accessing the Airport from the roundabout giving access to the Airport Road from L'Avenue de la Reine Elizabeth II and L'Avenue de la Commune is restricted to a one-way system as indicated.

9. Ownership and Approval

- 9.1. The Airport Director is the owner of this document and is responsible for ensuring it is reviewed and approved on or before the date set out in item in 10.2 below.

- (8) Unauthorised use of an unloading bay
- (9) Waiting on a "Disabled Drivers" parking area

Motor Traffic (Third Party Insurance) (Jersey) Law 1948
 The above Law requires any vehicle that is being used, and that includes being parked on a road or in a public place, display a valid insurance disc.

- (15) Failure to display a valid Windscreen Insurance Disc (You must attend at the Police Office, St Peter's Parish Hall on a Wednesday or Friday evening within 7 days. **Please contact the Parish Hall in advance by phone or email to make an appointment.**)

Change of Ownership
 You are obliged to notify the DVS of any change of address or ownership within 7 days. Failure to do so can result in prosecution.

IMPORTANT – PLEASE NOTE

Payment may be made by cheque (payable to the PARISH OF ST PETER) and sent to the Parish Hall, or by cash (in person) at the Parish Hall, or by card during office hours, Monday to Friday 9.00am to 4.00pm. Such payment does not fetter the Centenier's decision but prompt payment will in most cases result in no further action being taken.

If you do not admit to the alleged offence you are invited to attend a Parish Hall Enquiry within 7 days to discuss the matter with the Centenier to be held at the Police Office, St Peter's Parish Hall on a Wednesday or Friday evening. **Please contact the Parish Hall in advance by phone or email to make an appointment.**

Please bring your driving licence, insurance certificate and vehicle registration document.

Parking Restrictions in Specific Aerodrome Areas

1a) Overflow Car Park	Located on the left-hand side of the airport as you enter from the round about	Public parking area for passengers and visitors to the airport. Staff Parking No Motorcycles	Anytime
1b) Motorcycle Parking	Located on the approach road to the Car Rental Car Park	Motorcycles Parking only	Anytime
2c) Car Rental Parking	Take the first left on the airport road and then turn right	Car Rental drop-off and pick up car park only. Exclusive to authorised hire car vehicles	Anytime
4a) Departure Drop off Zone	Drop-off zone located between outside of the Departure Hall Building	Public drop-off zone, vehicles must not remain in location once passengers have been unloaded. Vehicles are not to be left un-attended.	Anytime
4b) Departure Bus Stop	Located after the drop off zone	No public parking/ waiting Authorized Buses only	Anytime
4c) Taxi Queuing Lane/ Taxi Rank	Starting after the departure bus stop and leading to the arrivals building	No Public access or parking	Anytime
4d) Bull ring	Central island located opposite the main car park and taxi rank	Taxi overflow parking Authorized vehicles only No public access	Anytime
5a) Short Stay Car Park	Adjacent to the Arrivals Hall	Public Parking Area Coach and Minibus only spaces around the left-hand perimeter of the car park Disabled parking only spaces – disabled badge to be displayed at all times.	Anytime

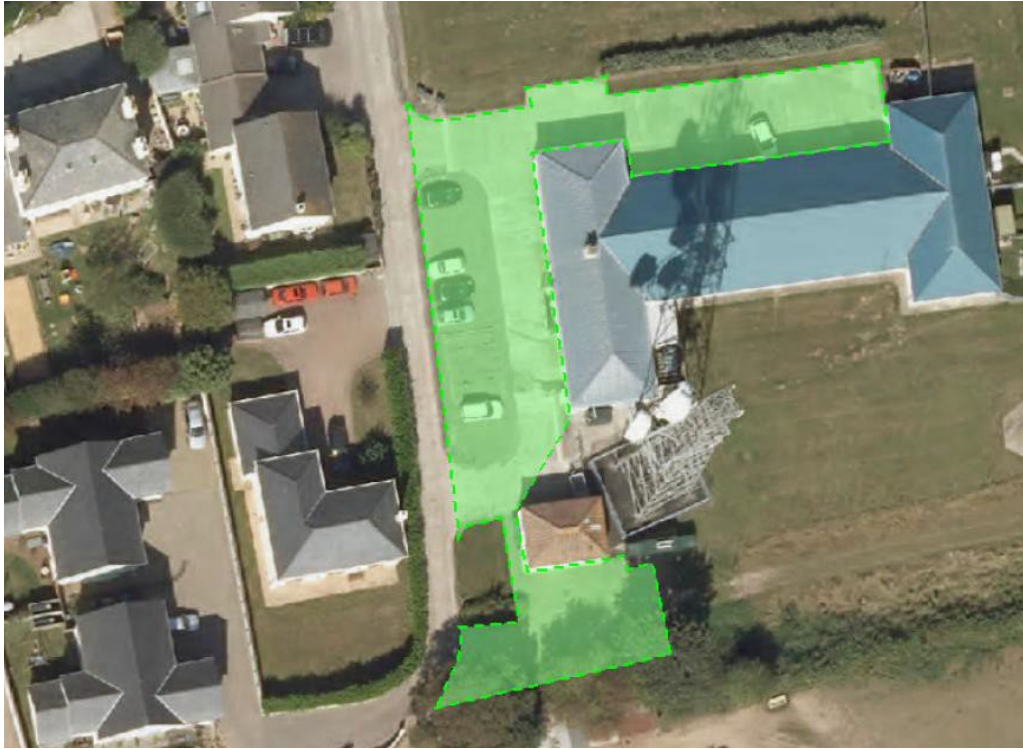
