

Guide to visiting St Helier Super yachts and training vessels





Pilotage

Pilotage is undertaken by Jersey Harbours and charges are detailed in the Commercial Tariffs published on portsofjersey.je, unless otherwise stated.

Pilotage is compulsory for all vessels **35 metres and over** in length, or if carrying **13 or more passengers**. Sailing vessels with a bow sprit are calculated using their waterline length.

Berths

All berths detailed below are Commercial Berths and are subject to ISPS compliance.

Albert Pier – No 3	Sump 3.4m BCD	Length 104m	Quay height ACD 13.0m
Albert Pier – No 2	Depth 2.0m BCD	Length 64m	Quay height ACD 13.0m
Victoria Pier – East Cross	Depth 2.2m BCD	Length 73m	Quay height ACD 13.0m

Shore access is via landing stages built into the Quay. Sailing vessels should consider yard height at LW and any possible conflicts with the Quay height.
