Pilotage

Pilotage is undertaken by Jersey Harbours and charges are detailed in the Commercial Tariffs published on portsofjersey.je, unless otherwise stated.

Pilotage is compulsory for all vessels **35 metres and over** in length, or if carrying **13 or more passengers**. Sailing vessels with a bow sprit are calculated using their waterline length.

All berths detailed below are Commercial Berths and are subject to ISPS compliance.

No 4: St Brelade's Bay (pilotage waiting anchorage) – gravel and sand	Max draft 13.0m	Max length: unlimited
No 5: South of Demie de Pas Light – 14m – rock and sand	Max draft 12.0m	Max length: unlimited
