As the summer season is upon us, Jersey Coastguard would like to promote the following safety advice for those who enjoy riding the surf line, whether a rookie or a pro.

- CHECK THE <u>WEATHER FORECAST</u> AND SWELL CONDITIONS The Shipping forecast can be obtained from the following sources: *Jersey Met website *Port of Jersey Website *Radio & television
- CHECK THE <u>TIDE</u>
 *Times of High and Low water *Be aware of Rip currents
- ENSURE YOU HAVE <u>SUITABLE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING</u>
 *Wet suit *Sun cream *Sunglasses *Warm clothing for after your activity
- BE AWARE OF OTHER <u>WATER USERS</u>
 *Ensure you are clear of the designated swimming areas
- TELL SOMEONE ASHORE OF YOUR INTENTIONS AND/OR DESTINATION
 *Advise family or friends of your intentions i.e. type of activity, where you are doing your activity *Expected duration of activity
- BE AWARE OF THE <u>DANGERS OF FINS AND BOARDS</u>
 *Fins and boards can cause serious injuries
- NOTIFY THE COASTGUARD IF ANY **EQUIPMENT IS LOST** AT SEA
- KNOW WHAT TO DO IN AN <u>EMERGENCY</u>
 *Know how to handle currents & to signal for help
