As the summer season is upon us, Jersey Coastguard would like to promote the following safety advice for Shoreline Anglers.

CHECK THE <u>WEATHER FORECAST</u> AND KEEP UP-TO-DATE The Shipping forecast can be obtained from the following sources: *Jersey Met website *Port of Jersey Website *Radio & television

CHECK THE TIDE

*Times of High and Low water *Be aware of currents close to the shore and wash from boats passing close to the shore *Avoid being cut off by the incoming tide

Ensure you have suitable <u>safety equipment</u>

*Wear a Life jacket if fishing in a precarious place *A means of communication *Torch *Sunglasses *Sun cream *First aid kit *Plenty of Drinking water

- ENSURE YOU ARE WEARING <u>SUITABLE CLOTHING</u>
 *Have warm clothing and waterproofs to hand *Wear Suitable footwear
- Tell someone ASHORE OF YOUR INTENTIONS AND/OR DESTINATION
 *Advise family or friends of your intentions *Where you are fishing *Number of persons
 *Expected duration of fishing trip
- TAKE CARE <u>ACCESSING REMOTE AREAS</u> ALONG THE COASTLINE *Use marked paths where possible
- FISH WITH A FRIEND
 *Especially in remote areas
- TAKE CARE WHEN HANDLING EQUIPMENT AND KNOW WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

*Be cautious with knives and hooks *Be careful when casting *Know who to call & how to explain your location to the emergency services
