

APPLICATION TO REGISTER A FISHING VESSEL

Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002

Please note the following points before completing this form

- Every fishing vessel must be licenced to fish by the Government of Jersey's Department of the Environment or the appropriate government department, before it may fish for profit or within six months of the certificate of registry having been issued.
- It is an offence to fish for profit without registering as a fishing vessel.
- The Registrar has the right to refuse or cancel registration of a fishing vessel if the vessel is deemed to be inappropriate (unsafe)
- The Registrar will issue instructions for the marking and measuring of the vessel.
- After inspection of the vessel, the Registrar will issue a Certificate of Registry.
- The fee for measurement and safety inspection is £54 and fee for registration is £50 – a total of £104
