

Notice to Mariners № 13 of 2020

Jersey Territorial Waters

Use of Leisure Vessels during Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic

This notice if effective from 0001 hrs BST Saturday 2nd May 2020

Owners/Operators of locally registered leisure vessels should keep up to date with the latest Government of Jersey advice by visiting <u>www.gov.je/coronavirus</u>.

Owners/Operators of leisure vessels operating from the Bailiwick of Jersey are required to:

- 1. Adhere to restrictions laid out in the latest GoJ Stay at Home instruction for the period of time permitted outside of the house each day.
- 2. Adhere to restrictions laid out in the latest GoJ Stay at home instruction regarding physical distancing and meeting others from outside of your household.
- Submit a Transit Report with Jersey Coastguard on VHF Channel 82, further detail on logging a Transit Report can be found here (<u>https://www.ports.je/JerseyCoastguard/Safety/Pages/VHFRadiosTransitIncident.as</u> <u>px</u>)
- Undertake suitable passage planning including checking the weather forecast, ensure their vessels are well maintained and seaworthy. Carry approriate safety equipment for all onboard and the passage they are undertaking. More information can be found here (https://www.ports.je/JerseyCoastguard/Safety/Pages/Safety.aspx)
- 5. Remain within Jersey Territorial Waters at all times
- 6. If planning to visit outlying reefs give consideration to requirements for physical distancing and time periods permitted out of the house
- 7. Maintain physical distancing within public areas such as piers, marinas, pontoons, ramps and facilities

This notice will remain in force until a cancellation notice is issued.
