Elizabeth Marina Storm Gate Reinstatement

Repairs to the Elizabeth Marina storm gate are underway and it is planned for reinstatement at the entrance of Elizabeth marina in November. A barge will be used to lift the gate from its temporary location on the NNQ to take it back to Elizabeth marina.

The project will be undertaken in 3 parts:

Part A | Enabling works in Elizabeth marina will commence on **25th October**.

- A team of specialist divers will undertake work on the gate infrastructure at the entrance to the marina for up to 19 days.
- This will result in reduced periods of access due to 'stoplogs' and the marina tidal gates being locked in the upright position.
- St Helier VTS will manage access to the marina.
- Separate NtoMs will be issued specific to this part of the works.

Part B | The lifting operation and relocation of the gate using the Antigoon barge from the NNQ back to the marina is planned for the **15th November** and will last for a maximum period of 3 days.


- During this time there will be no access for vessels to or from the marina.
- A separate NtoM will be issued specific to this part of the works.

Part C | Completion works. The specialist divers will continue to work on the gate infrastructure once the gate is back insitu to complete the reinstatement of the gate. This will be undertaken over the LW period and will not affect access/egress from the marina.

- A separate NtoM will be issued specific to this part of the works.
