



## **Notice to Mariners № 30 of 2021** **St Helier Harbour | BA3278**

### **Elizabeth Marina Storm Gate Reinstatement – Part A | Gate infrastructure enabling works**

With reference to NtoM 28 of 2021

Prior to the reinstatement of the storm gate, specialist divers will be undertaking enabling works on the gate infrastructure.

Duration of works: **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> October – Monday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021**

During these works the tidal gate will be locked in the upright position and ‘stoplogs’ installed to partially dam the marina entrance.

- The gate and stoplogs will result in a reduced depth of water at the entrance and therefore, a reduced tidal access window for the marina.
- The marina IALA lights will be set to red at all times for the duration
- St Helier VTS will manage the access to the marina during this period of the work
- **Mariners wishing to enter or exit the marina must request permission from St Helier VTS on VHF ch14 prior to traversing the cill, giving their draft and direction of travel.**
- A navigational warning will be broadcast by St Helier VTS
- NtoM 12 of 2021 will be cancelled on installation of the additional stoplogs on the 29<sup>th</sup> October.

This notice will self-cancel on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021.
