



## Notice to Mariners No 20 of 2022

### Jersey Territorial Waters

#### African Swine Fever: Pork importation restrictions

Mariners are advised of the following restrictions which have been brought into force with immediate effect:

New [restrictions on the importation of pork and pork products](#) have been introduced in Jersey to help prevent the spread of African swine fever.

With immediate effect, it is illegal to bring pork or pork products into the Island from Europe (excluding the UK and other Channel Islands), unless it is:

- 2kg or less for human consumption in the original unopened packaging and clearly health marked; or
- 2kg or less of pet feed in an unopened manufacturer-sealed package.

There are no new limits on pork or products imported **commercially**, so long as it is in the original unopened packaging, it is imported by (or for delivery to) a registered food business, and it is clearly health marked.
