Marine Services

Our Marine Services Department deals with all on-water aspects of Ports of Jersey. From maintaining the aids to navigation buoys and

lighthouses, to surveying and pilotage, it is a long list! Off-island, we operate our two tug vessels 'Duke of Normandy' and 'Duchess' commercially.

Tugboats. Or you could become an Engineer on our vessels, developing skills to maintain all our workboats and any equipment they might carry.

Coastguard and Vessel Traffic Services

The Maritime Operations Centre is manned 24 hrs a day by seven Watch Officers and two Specialist Watch Officers who are all dual trained in Vessel Traffic Services (VTS) and Coastguard Search & Rescue (SAR) operations, therefore, it won't surprise you that no two days/nights will be the same. As a Watch Officer, you must be prepared for anything and be comfortable switching from the routine and predictable to the unusual and fast paced emergency situations.

Typically, a Watch Officer will earn their stripes for a couple of years before progressing to the role of Specialist Watch Officer. A Specialist Watch Officers primary role is Search and Rescue operations and supervision of VTS. It is not unusual for Watch Officers to further their careers in other Maritime departments within Ports of Jersey.

Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Service

The dedicated team at the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Service protect and provide a safe environment to all passengers, employees, third party operators and anyone else who may use our Airport. While luckily they don't tackle aircraft accidents every day, they continually contribute to the safety of the Airport through a wide variety of tasks including first aid assistance, wildlife and habitat control, actively monitoring and auditing aviation safety and security, among many other functions.

The role of Firefighter is unique and no experience is necessary, you need to be enthusiastic about learning, open to developing yourself, be a good team player, have a good level of fitness and be able to obtain a HGV driving licence.



Capital Projects

The Capital Projects Team is involved in the planning, co-ordination and delivery of all capital projects across Ports of Jersey's varied estate. No two projects are the same and include large scale construction projects at the Airport or Harbour and assisting with the integration of new technology. They're responsible for ensuring that we deliver the right project at the right time for the right cost. and they work with teams from across the business and external stakeholders.



Air Traffic Control

We have a wide variety of roles, including Air Traffic Controllers who start as a Trainee, before progressing to work in the Control Tower and Air traffic support coordinators, who provide the weather from the control tower as well as support the Air Traffic Controllers.

Air Traffic Control is responsible for providing an air traffic control service and aviation weather

service to the aircraft that come into and out of Jersey Airport, as well as the aircraft that fly in the wider Channel Islands airspace. We have a wide variety of roles, including Air traffic support coordinators.

There are lots of opportunities for progression and also to specialise in technical roles such as assessors and in airspace management and safety.

Group Technical Services

The Group Technical Services team strive to provide safe, effect and value-added technical services for Ports of Jersey across multiple disciplines, whether it is maritime or aviation operations, IT services and support, air navigation services, or contributing to large infrastructure projects.

GTS has more than 30 roles within the team, ranging from fitters and mechanics to IT Specialists and Planning Engineers. The wider team has only recently integrated, creating lots of opportunity for cross-functional working, so some days you might be working with the Maritime team and some you might be working at the Airport.
