

## Safety Bulletin 03 of 2019

### Use of Lifting Equipment

Lifting equipment within St Helier Harbour and all Outlying Harbours should be used and maintained as outlined under the 'Safety in Docks and Outlying Harbours (Jersey) Code of Practice'.

The following extracts are from the Code of Practice and are specific to the use of lifting equipment and its maintenance.

***"Lifting Operations | Use of Lifting Equipment***

*67 All cranes and lifting appliances used on the Ports of Jersey estate, including those used at the outlying harbours, must comply with the Cranes and Lifting Appliances (Jersey) Regulations 1978."*

***"Lifting Operations | Maintenance of Lifting Equipment and Lifting Accessories***

*77 All lifting equipment and accessories should be inspected and examined by suitably trained and competent people."*
