Installation of New Electrical Supply Breakers (RCD) in Elizabeth and La Collette Marinas

Ports of Jersey have recently updated and installed devices that will instantly disconnect an electrical circuit in the event of an electric shock or surge of current. This will ensure greater future resilience, customer assurance and safety when berthing in the two marinas.

Ports of Jersey would like to request your co-operation in encouraging you to inspect your vessel's connections to the shore supply for the following issues or areas:

- Charred/stained in line 16amp/32amp connections
- Evidence of dampness
- Light corrosion of connections
- Damaged wires
- Exposed wiring from connections

In remaining vigilant and rectifying these issues early, we will be able to ensure that the electrical supply remains safe and that it continues to provide a sound service to all users of the marinas in the coming Summer months.
