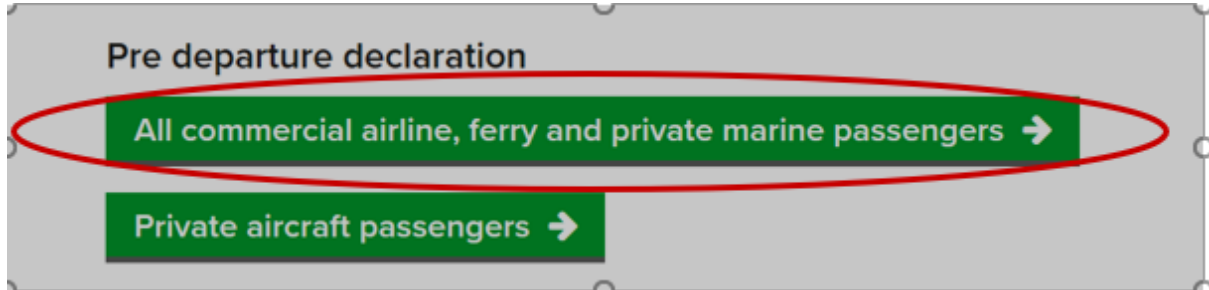

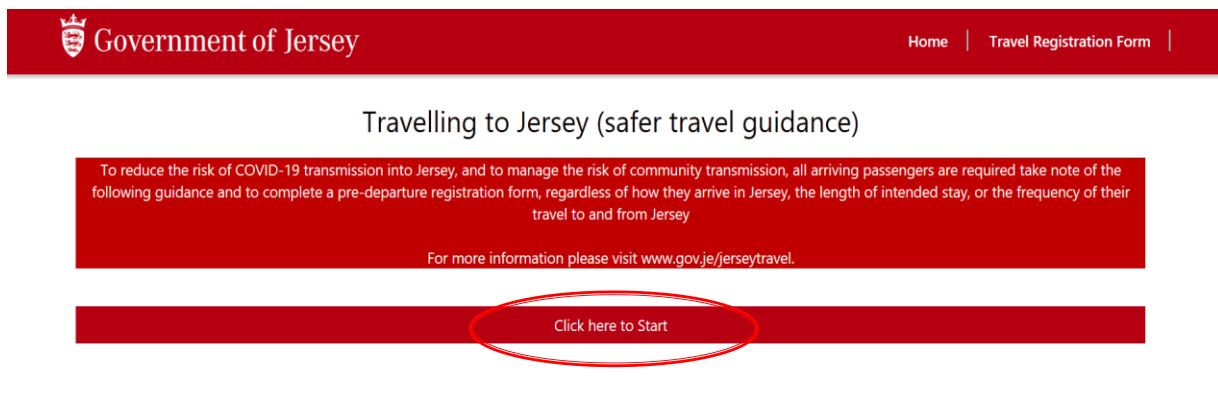



Declaration

1. I confirm that I have read and understand the information provided about the Government of Jersey's Safer Travel programme on the Government of Jersey website and in the Guidance to travellers on COVID-19 testing requirements. 2. I understand that if:
 - a. I do not consent to being tested or screened on arrival in Jersey; or
 - b. I do not provide approved documentary evidence prior to departure of a previous negative COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to my arrival in Jersey I will be required to immediately comply with mandatory self-isolation requirements under the COVID-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation) (Jersey) Regulations 2020. Should you wish to send us a copy of the documentary evidence of a previous negative COVID-19 test for consideration, please e-mail it to pcrtravelcerts@gov.je. Please ensure you complete the rest of this form and tick the declaration at the end.
3. I understand that if:
 - a. I do not consent to, or fail to comply with any requirement to take a test required during my stay in Jersey or otherwise do not co-operate with arrangements for assessment or screening for COVID-19; or The clinical advice, based on the results of any of my COVID-19 tests, requires it then I will be required to immediately comply with mandatory self-isolation requirements under the COVID-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation) (Jersey) Regulations 2020.
 - b. I understand that if I am staying with others during my visit, they may also be required to self-isolate as well. To the best of my knowledge any person I will share living accommodation with is aware of this and consents to my living with them.
4. I understand that, depending on the results of my COVID-19 test, the period of self-isolation required may vary. I understand that it could result in a requirement to extend my stay in Jersey until it is completed and could exceed the initial 14-day self-isolation requirement upon arriving into Jersey.
5. I understand that failure to comply with any requirement to self-isolate in accordance with the Regulations is a criminal offence and that I will be liable to prosecution and a fine
6. I understand that failure to comply with any reasonable instructions from an authorised officer of the Government of Jersey in respect of these matters, or obstructing their work, is a criminal offence and that I will be liable to prosecution and a fine of up to £10,000 and in some cases to imprisonment.
7. I understand that if I am travelling with passengers for which I have legal responsibility, including passengers who are under 16 years old and those who are unable to give consent, I will be required to complete this declaration on behalf of those other passengers for which I have legal responsibility.
8. I understand that my information will be shared with the relevant government authorities, as referenced below, for the purposes of travel to / from Jersey.

Please note that your personal data collected for the purposes of the COVID travel scheme, including data about the outcome of tests and need for self-isolation, will be shared by the Health Department and Environmental Health Department with the Police and other authorised officers for the purposes of reducing their risk of infection. Your data will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018. Your data will not be used for any other purpose and will be destroyed in line with Government of Jersey retention schedules. Confirmation received and QR code will be sent to the email address provided. Your confirmation will also provide you with your 'travel status' based on your travel history (Red/Amber/Green). **Please refer to the Isolation information below.**

Isolation period

Under the [COVID-19 \(Screening, Assessment and Isolation\) \(Jersey\) Regulations 2020](#) all passengers arriving in Jersey will be required to self-isolate after their arrival unless given permission not to do so.

When following this guidance, you must isolate as follows:

Category	Testing requirements	Time period for isolation
No PCR test (or exemptions) upon arrival	not applicable	14 days
Green countries only in travel declaration and PCR test on arrival	PCR test on arrival&	no isolation requirement
Amber country in travel declaration	PCR test on arrival* and on day 5 after arrival*	self-isolation until negative result after day 5 PCR test
Red country in travel declaration	PCR test on arrival*	14 days isolation

* Exemption from test on arrival only, if you submit evidence of a negative PCR test conducted in your country of departure.

In Jersey, failure to self-isolate when required to is a criminal offence. If you don't self-isolate when required to do so, you can be fined up to £1,000.

While you are self-isolating, you can still expect to receive an automated text message from the Contact Tracing Service on a daily basis to self-report if you have developed symptoms for up to 14 days after your arrival or until you leave the Island, whichever period is shorter.
