



Notice to Mariners № 02 of 2021 - Updated

Jersey Harbours

GoJ Safer Travel Testing Programme and travelling to other jurisdictions – COVID-19

Mariners are advised of the following requirements relating to all vessels and passengers wishing to land persons ashore in the Bailiwick of Jersey including all harbours and outlying reefs. This includes Jersey residents returning on-board leisure vessels that have landed ashore in other jurisdictions outside of the Bailiwick of Jersey.

All arrivals must adhere to the Government of Jersey Safer Travel Testing Programme.

Travelling to Jersey after 2 November 2021

1. All passengers aged 11 and over arriving in Jersey should:
 - complete a travel form within 48 hours before arriving in Jersey
 - follow testing and isolation rules (Safer Travel programme) or isolate for 10 days

Passengers who do not complete the form before departure can expect to be delayed on arrival in Jersey.

2. Isolation

Passengers can avoid arrival testing and isolation requirements by declaring any one of the following on their travel form:

- fully vaccinated status
- recently recovered from COVID-19: Confirmed by positive PCR test in the 90 to 10 days before arrival in Jersey
- pre-departure PCR test conducted within 72 hours of arrival in Jersey

All other passengers aged 11 and over are required to undergo a PCR test on arrival and isolate until negative test result

3. Visiting Leisure Vessels

In addition to the requirements of the Safer Travel Programme, visiting leisure vessels wishing to land persons ashore should pre-book a berth, prior to arrival, with Jersey Marinas and will be required to arrive at the designated port of **St Helier only**. Visiting vessels arriving in St Helier that have not pre-booked may not be accepted. Jersey Marinas can be contacted on +44(0) 1534 447730 / 447708 or jerseymarinas@ports.je to book a berth.

4. Travelling to other jurisdictions

Mariners including leisure vessels and Small Commercial Vessels are also reminded to ensure they have checked the pre-arrival requirements of other jurisdictions they are planning to visit or carry passengers to. Official Government advice from the appropriate authorities of other jurisdictions should be referred to and requirements may include but not be limited to:

- Pre-registration
- Pre-departure testing
- Arrival testing
- Isolation requirements
- Essential only travel restrictions

This notice will remain in force until further notice.
